The Institute for Education is accepting late applications submitted online for the part-time blended course *Master of Education (MQF 7, 90 ECTS)* in **October 2019**. Late applications will be received on a first-come first-served basis.

Course Details

This programme is targeted towards professionals who wish to enhance their skills and competences in pedagogy. The target audience is either qualified individuals wishing to join to education sector, or persons already within education sector with a need to upgrade their qualifications. It aims to equip participants with the necessary tools and competences to teach effectively in the 21st century classroom whilst fostering a supportive and inclusive environment for learning.

- Agribusiness
- Engineering Technology
- Hospitality



Exit Qualification

Applicants following this programme shall be entitled to a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (MQF 7, 60 ECTS) upon successfully completing two years of this programme in pedagogy.

Minimum Entry requirements

Applicants interested in following this programme are required to satisfy the eligibility criteria as indicated in the Annex at the end of this circular.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €360 on an annual basis. International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €2,700 (80% of which is non-refundable except under exceptional circumstances). Participants applying for the *Master of Education (MQF 7)* are required to be in possession of the following:

Sciences	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English and Mathematics;</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 70 ECTS in the natural sciences: Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics.</p>
Agribusiness	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English and Mathematics</p> <p>AND</p> <p>2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 70 ECTS in Agribusiness or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*</p> <p>In addition to the above, applicants may be requested to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance on the programme.</p> <p>*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in Agribusiness subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.</p>

Engineering Technology

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English and Mathematics

AND

2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 70 ECTS in Engineering Technology or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*

In addition to the above, applicants may be requested to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance on the programme.

*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in Engineering Technology subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.

Hospitality

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English and Mathematics

AND

2. Applicants are to be in possession of a Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 70 ECTS in Hospitality or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*

In addition to the above, applicants may be requested to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance on the programme.

*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in hospitality subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.
