

COMPULSORY COURSE FOR SUPPLY LEARNING SUPPORT ASSISTANTS

DURATION: 70 contact hours, 134 self-study hours, 110 hands-on hours and 96 assessment hours.

MQF Level: MQF Level 4 Award

TARGET GROUP: Supply Learning Support Assistants who are already in employment but lack basic training in supporting identified learners.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Participants need to be employed as Supply Learning Support Assistance.

COURSE RATIONALE: Teaching grades will get a mixture of pedagogy and classroom management skills when using the tablets in class. The course will be based on recent research, both local and foreign, on tablet pedagogy in the classroom. The course will be complemented with practical tasks.

OVERALL COURSE OBJECTIVES: The course is intended to prepare learners to work with children as Supply Learning Support Assistant in a classroom situation. The qualifications provide the theoretical knowledge and understanding of child development and education in addition to this the learner will at the end of the course have the needed skills to be able to support the learners (children) assigned to them in a professional way as dictated by the Inclusion Policy. The training will also enable the participants to support learners with diverse educational needs.

The qualifications aim to allow learners to:

- Develop an in-depth knowledge and understanding of child development , education
- Plan according to the diverse needs of the children
- Health and safety of children and the value of play
- Develop their professional skills and vocationally appropriate competence
- Implement, evaluate and reflect on professional practice
- Develop an understanding of inclusive practice and value diversity.
